Seattle, WA – February 17, 2017 – The musicians of the Ladies Musical Club of Seattle (LMC) will present seven FREE public concerts during March 2017 at Seattle Art Museum, Frye Art Museum, Seattle Central Public Library, West Seattle Library, University House Wallingford, Bellevue's Crossroads Community Center Theater and Music Center of the Northwest (venue addresses and full concert listing are below). The FREE programs are performed in an intimate-setting, appropriate for all ages, and approximately one-hour in length. The concert at MCNW is 90-minutes, with an intermission and refreshments following.

Ladies Musical Club of Seattle kicks off the month of March with soprano Tiina Ritalahti presenting songs by Wolf and Turina and pianist Lisa Lanza performing music by W. F. Bach, Chopin Prokofiev and Schumann on Thursday, March 2 at 12:00 p.m. at Seattle Art Museum in the Plestcheeff Auditorium as part of the museum's free First Thursday events. Soprano Susan Strick will offer songs by Fauré and Tchaikovsky while pianist Katie O'Rourke will celebrate the birthday month of composer J.S. Bach with selections from his The Well-Tempered Clavier, Book II at the Frye Art Museum on Saturday, March 4 at 2:00 p.m. On Wednesday, March 8, the LMC program at 12:00 p.m. at the Seattle Central Public Library will also feature pianist Katie O'Rourke, performing selections from J.S. Bach's The Well-Tempered Clavier, Book II, lullabies by soprano Ya-Li Lee, personal compositions by guitarist Hilary Field, and a trio of special music with Lee, Field and soprano Christine Menschner. French/British songs and duets of the late Romantic period will be performed at the West Seattle Public Library on Sunday, March 12 at 3:00 p.m. Music for song and dance will be presented at the University House Wallingford on Monday, March 13 at 7:30 p.m. A program of Irish folk song and music for voice, piano and English horn with soprano Breanna Hanson, soprano Tiina Ritalahti and Gail Perstein, English horn, is on tap at Crossroads Community Center Theater in Bellevue on Friday, March 17 at 7:30 p.m. The month of free concerts concludes at the Music Center of the Northwest on Saturday, March 18 at 7:00 p.m., with soprano Regina Thomas and pianist Maria Khavin performing music by Beethoven with a special opera presentation by of Scenes from La Clemenza di Titi (the Clemency of Titus) by W. A. Mozart, with five singers, a string quartet, piano, costumes, set and commentary. The program features an intermission and post-concert refreshments.

Classical KING FM 98.1's NW Focus Live program with host Sean Maclean will feature an on-air interview and performance by two solo winners of LMC's prestigious Frances Walton Competition — **Dana Jackson**, bassoon, and **Aaron Conitz**, viola — on **Friday, March 24 at 8:00 p.m.** For more information on NW Focus Live, visit www.king.org.

Dana Jackson, bassoon, and Aaron Conitz, viola, winners of the Frances Walton Competition, will perform. In June, the <a href="Music in Schools">2017 Frances Walton Competition</a> will be held that expands the careers of 20-35 year old classical artists in piano, voice, strings and instruments, who live, work or study in Western states.

Ladies Musical Club of Seattle was founded in 1891 by a group of 24 women musicians. Its original mission was to foster an appreciation of classical music in the cultural life of a city that was just starting to find its identity. For more than a century, LMC presented a stellar International Artist Series whose make up is literally a Who's Who list of classical music artist luminaries such as: Sergei Rachmaninoff, Fritz Kreisler, Jascha Heifetz, Marian Anderson, Kirsten Flagstad, Artur Rubinstein, Vladimir Horowitz, Marilyn Horne, Alicia de Larrocha, Nadja Salerno-Sonnenberg, Joshua Bell, and the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, the New York Symphony Orchestra, and the London Chamber Orchestra as well. See the entire list. Although no longer able to afford such artist fees, LMC continues to foster classical music in the community through education, performance and awards. MOHAI houses LMC's historical archives.
