LMC'S TO PRESENT FREE PUBLIC CONCERTS IN EIGHT SEATTLE AREA VENUES IN NOVEMBER

**LMC Musicians to Present Two FREE concerts at the
Museum of Flight's "SpaceFest 2016 — Ladies Who Launch"
Kick-Off Event on Thursday, November 3 at 6:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.**

Seattle, WA – The historic **Ladies Musical Club of Seattle (LMC)**, celebrating its 125th year of operation, will present **FREE public concerts during November 2016** at **Seattle Art Museum, Frye Art Museum, Seattle Central Public Library, West Seattle Library, Mirabella** in South Lake Union, **University House/Wallingford** and **Crossroads Community Center Theater** in Bellevue (all season venue addresses are listed below).

In addition to these venues, on **Thursday, November 3**, the **Ladies Musical Club** will perform two free musical concerts in the Museum of Flight's **Charles Simonyi Space Gallery** at **6:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.** to kick off the museum's third annual **"SpaceFest 2016—Ladies Who Launch."** The two identical musical programs will feature **Kathryn Zufall**, violin, **Madeline Beery**, flute, with vocal selections by **Katie Hochman**, soprano, and **Catherine Treadgold**, mezzo-soprano. The weekend of events and speakers at the museum will feature "astronauts, authors, doctors and inspired aerospace insiders, spanning entry level engineers to EDL experts!" Museum of Flight is located at 9404 East Marginal Way S, Seattle Washington.

Other **November program highlights**: At 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 3 in the Seattle Art Museum, **Angie Kam**, violin, will perform J.S. Bach's Sonata No. 1 in G minor for solo violin, and soprano **Christine Menschner**, guest tenor **Brian Minnick**, and noted classical guitarist **Hilary Field** will present a delightful "Art of German Folksong" program. Soprano **Ya-Li Lee** will sing Schumann's romantic *Liederkreis*, Op. 39, with pianist **Johanna Mastenbrook** on Saturday, November 5, at 2:00 p.m. at the Frye Art Museum. On Monday, November 14 at 7:30 p.m. at the University House/Wallingford, LMC will present an **evening of string chamber music**. Scenes from **Mozart's two-act opera La Clemenza di Tito**, staged with costumes and accompanied by a string quartet and piano, will be performed at the Crossroads Community Center Theatre on Friday, November 18 at 7:30 p.m. Works by LMC composers **Sarah Conyers, Kathy Roberts, Nicole Truesdale** and **Janet Anderson** will be featured in the Emerald Hall performance at Mirabella on Sunday, November 20 at 3:00 p.m.

Most performances are one-hour in length. During the season, LMC also will bring classical and world music to Seattle Public Schools through its **Music in Schools** program that collaborates with **Meany Center for the Performing Arts**. In June, the **2017 Frances Walton Competition** will be held that expands the careers of 20-35 year old classical artists in piano, voice, strings and instruments, who live, work or study in Western states.

Ladies Musical Club of Seattle was founded in **1891** by a group of **24 women musicians**. Its original mission was to foster an appreciation of classical music in the cultural life of a city that was just starting to find its identity. For more than a century, LMC presented a stellar International Artist Series whose make up is literally a Who's Who list of classical music artist luminaries such as: **Sergei Rachmaninoff, Fritz Kreisler, Jascha Heifetz, Marian Anderson, Kirsten Flagstad, Artur Rubinstein, Vladimir Horowitz, Marilyn Horne, Alicia de Larrocha, Nadja Salerno-Sonnenberg, Joshua Bell**, and the **Chicago Symphony Orchestra, the New York Symphony Orchestra**, and the **London Chamber Orchestra** as well.
