BY-LAWS

OF THE

Ladies Musical Club

OF

Seattle, Washington

ARTICLE I.

The Ladies' Musical Club is an association of women, formed for the purpose of developing the musical talent of its members and stimulating musical interest in Seattle.

ARTICLE II.

OFFICERS.

SEC. 1. The management of the Club shall be vested in a President, who shall be the chief officer of the Club, a Vice-President, a Recording Secretary, a Corresponding Secretary, a Treasurer, and an Executive Committee of four persons, who shall also constitute the Board of Trustees, and who shall hold their offices for one year and until their successors are elected and qualified, and shall have power to fill any vacancy that shall occur in their number.

SEC. 2. The President, Vice-President, two Secretaries and the Treasurer of the Board of Trustees shall be elected by ballot of all the active members present, at an annual meeting called for that purpose on the fourth Monday in May.

SEC. 3. The Board of Officers shall make such rules for the government of the Club as may seem to it proper; which rules, when published with and subject to this constitution, shall be the law of the Club.

SEC. 4. The Board of Officers and Trustees shall appoint the time and place of holding the opening concert of each season, and thereafter concerts shall be given at intervals of two weeks during the season, and shall be managed by sub-committees appointed by the President. But no sub-committee shall have the right to change the time and place of a concert without permission of the President.

ARTICLE III.

MEMBERS.

SEC. 1. There shall be three classes of members—Active, Student and Associate.

SEC. 2. The Active Membership of the Club shall consist exclusively of women. There may also be an Associate Membership of men and women.

SEC. 3. All Active Members shall hold themselves in readiness to contribute to the entertainment of the Club when required.

SEC. 4. Any member prevented from filling her place on the program must provide a substitute satisfactory to the committee in charge or pay a fine of \$1.00.

SEC. 5. Non-attendance of members at three consecutive meetings (active), will result in loss of membership ticket—unless adequate excuse for such non-attendance be furnished in writing to the Secretary.

SEC. 6. Candidates for Active Membership shall be required to perform at a regular or special meeting of Active Members. The election shall be by secret ballot—five black balls preventing an election.

SEC. 7. Candidates for Active Membership shall be required to furnish the endorsement of two Active Members of the Club.

SEC. 8. Student Members shall be admitted to all active meetings, as well as all regular concerts and artists' recitals, but shall have no voice in the government of the Club.

SEC. 9. Applicants for Student Membership must be studying at the present time, and be recommended by teacher. They must perform before a committee. None are eligible under sixteen years of age.

ARTICLE IV.

FEES.

SEC. 1. The annual dues for Active Members shall be \$3.00; those for Student Members, \$4.00; those for Associate Members, \$5.00, payable the second Monday in October.

SEC. 2. Dues for Active and Student Membership shall become delinquent the second Monday in November. When dues are delinquent membership for the year will be forfeited, unless there be the excuse of illness or absence from the city.

SEC. 3. Active Members who have allowed their dues to lapse for two successive years will forfeit their membership.

ARTICLE V.

SEC. 1. Active and Student Membership tickets shall not be transferable.

ARTICLE VI.

An Auditor shall be appointed by the Executive Committee, to whom the Treasurer shall submit the financial account of the Club every three months.

ARTICLE VII.

The office of President, Vice-President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary or Treasurer shall not be held by one person for more than two years in succession.

ARTICLE VIII.

AMENDMENT.

These by-laws may be amended at any regular or special meeting by a vote of two-thirds of Active Members present, notice of the intention to amend the same forming a part of the call to the meeting.

ARTICLE IX.

The monthly concerts shall be open to the public, on the payment of fifty cents admission.

ARTICLE X.

DUTIES OF OFFICERS.

SEC. 1. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Club and Board of Officers.

SEC. 2. The Vice-President shall, in the absence of the President, perform all the duties pertaining to that office.

SEC. 3. The Recording Secretary shall keep a record of all meetings of the Club and Board of officers; shall keep a complete list of all members, and shall record the attendance of members at Active Members' meetings and shall issue membership tickets.

SEC. 4. The Corresponding Secretary shall attend to all necessary correspondence of the Club, and shall, when the President calls a Board meeting, notify the members.

SEC. 5. The Treasurer shall receive and have control of all money of the Club, holding the same in trust; shall keep a full account of the finances of the Club, and present a monthly report of the same at the active meetings.

SEC. 6. The Librarian shall keep an account of all the books, magazines and music, and shall be responsible for same.

ARTICLE XI.

CONCERT COMMITTEES.

SEC. 1. The Board of Officers must attend to the arranging and printing of programs; the engaging of professional musicians when necessary, and the ordering of pianos, music stands, etc. Concert Committees should be at the hall fifteen minutes before each meeting to see that everything is in order.

SEC. 2. None but Club Members are expected to perform at the concerts. Exceptions may be made when necessary in favor of male singers, women who are not residents of the city, and stringed instruments.

SEC. 3. Should a member of the Concert Committee be obliged to resign her position, she must first provide a suitable substitute to take her place, or pay a fine of \$1.00.

SEC. 4. Concert Committees must keep an exact record of the Club Members invited by them to perform, and the reasons given whenever they refuse to do so.

SEC. 5. Concert Committees are requested to apply to the Treasurer for reimbursement of all sums expended by them for stationery, postage, car fare, etc. The Board must approve all purchases of music made by the Concert Committees. The Board will not be responsible for the payment of any bills contracted by unauthorized persons.

SEC. 6. The time of meeting shall be 2:30 p. m.

SEC. 7. At all concerts and artists' recitals, the Club Members, both Active and Associate, are desired to show their membership tickets to the doorkeeper.

SEC. 8. No departure from the foregoing by-laws can be made without special permission from the Board of Officers.

ARTICLE XII.

SOCIAL COMMITTEES.

SEC. 1. The Active Member meetings were organized to promote personal acquaintance among the Active Members of the Club. The Social Committee has therefore been appointed to preside over the Active Member meetings, and its duties are as follows:

SEC. 2. To introduce new or unknown members of the Club to the President, Vice-President, and other officers of the Club, and to other members interested in the same branch of music, as, for instance, singers to singers, pianists to pianists, etc.

SEC. 3. To endeavor to make all the new or unknown members feel welcome and at ease, and to diffuse an informal geniality into these meetings.
