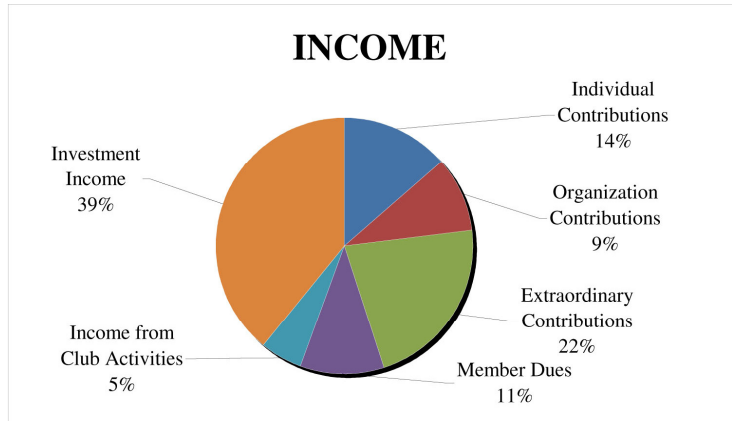

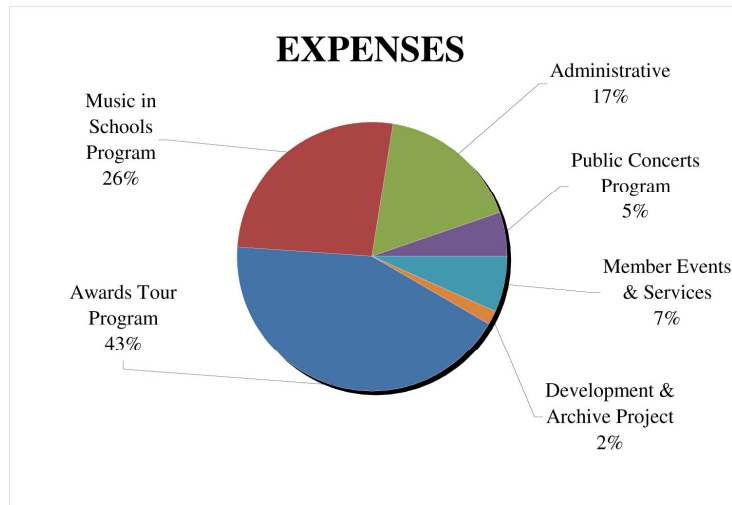

2013 – 2014 The Year in Review

Founded on March 24, 1891, Ladies Musical Club (LMC) continues to foster an appreciation of classical music within our community. With over 120 members, LMC has reached many children, students and adults who otherwise would not have had access to our excellent programs. Your commitment enabled us to add immeasurable value to the arts and culture in our community.

Public Concerts

Between October 2013 and May 2014, our public concerts reached a total of 2,789 people at the Seattle Art Museum (530), Frye Art Museum (639), the main branch of the Seattle Public Library (458), West Seattle Library (337), University House Wallingford (403), Mirabella (312), and the Ballard Oddfellows Lodge (110).

A new venue has been added, the Theater at Crossroads Community Center in Bellevue. Concerts are scheduled for the third Friday evenings throughout 2014-2015. We are looking forward to developing an audience in the Eastside and promoting our performances in this diverse community.



Music In Schools Program (MIS)



During the 2013-2014 school year, Music in Schools Outreach Program reached over 9,000 students in eight elementary schools through 19 interactive presentations and activities. The six participating schools were First Place (a school for homeless children), Highland Park, Pinehurst, Rainier View, Sandpoint and Southshore K-8. MIS continued to support the Maple School Chorus and also facilitated another presentation at Martin Luther King, Jr. Elementary.

MIS is deeply grateful for the encouragement and financial support of our individual LMC members and friends, as well as for contributions from The Fales Foundation, 4Culture and the King County Employees' Giving Program.

Frances Walton Competition

The June 2013 competition drew many highly talented and accomplished musicians. The winners performed on KING-FM's Northwest Focus Live: Stefan Van Sant, clarinet, and Rachel Policar, soprano in September; and Jacob Adams, viola and Linda Tsatsanis, soprano, in March. Recitals were held in Yakima, Chelan, Omak, Forks, Illwaco, and Ferndale. Schools visited included locations in Yakima, East Wenatchee, Wenatchee, Chelan, Pateros, Okanogan, Oroville, Long Beach, Ilwaco, Winlock, Quilcene, Aberdeen, Olympia, Ferndale, Everson and Chehalis.
